Aged for one year in smaller barrels, this mouth-filling and hedonistic wine reveals spectacular finesse and elegance with fine tannins and a persistent mineral structure. A superb white from Calce. From a rainier vintage, the 2018 Domaine de l'Horizon Blanc offers a pure, fresh and lemony, discreet rather than hedonistic nose compared to the generous 2019. The aromas are herbal and floral and still shy, though the wine already indicates substance and structure on the nose. On the palate, this is also a rich and round yet more astringent Blanc that seems to be in a valley at this early stage. The 2017 Domaine de l'Horizon Blanc is abnormally matured for a wine less than five years old and reveals prominent oxidative fruit notes that are reminiscent of sweet and ripe grape berries during the harvest. Matured, stewed and dried apple aromas on the nose lead to a creamy-textured, elegant palate that lacks vibrant acidity and comes across as rich but a bit broad. Rather disappointing due to a lack of tension and mineral freshness. Natural cork. 13% stated alcohol. Tasted in Oldenburg, Germany, in February 2022.

Selected only one time so far and aged in barrels for 18 months, the 2014 Domaine de l'Horizon Blanc Grande Reserve offers a deep, intense and generous yet refined and wonderfully reductive bouquet of perfectly ripe and elegant fruit intertwined with citrus and herbal notes. This is deep, dark and complex like a Meursault. Full-bodied, rich and lush but enormously tight and stimulatingly salty, this is a refreshing white from Calce and the greatest, finest and most complex wine ever bottled in the first 15 years of Domaine de l'Horizon. The finish is very dense, very intense, very long and aromatic, but it remains fresh, finessed and mineral, despite its power. Not yet in the market, the 2014 Domaine de l'Horizon Rouge Grande Reserve is a selection of the finest barrels of the vintage. The still dark-colored blend of Carignan and Grenache Noir offers a pure yet intense and complex bouquet of ripe, dark fruits intertwined with lemony notes, chalk and iron-rich slate. This seven-year-old red is excitingly intense but refined and elegant on the earthy nose that offers ripe black-cherry aromas. Silky and fresh on the palate, this is a full-bodied and concentrated, very intense and stimulatingly salty red with remarkably silky tannins and refreshing mineral vitality. The finish is long and intense and reveals perfect maturity, yet the wine still remains on the younger side. This drinks perfectly well today, but it can be aged for at least another 10 years. The 2014 is a fascinatingly pure, intense and balanced but also tensioned, vital and astringent red wine that I would definitely buy as an icon wine of the Roussillon. Tasted in March 2022.
